Department of Assamese, Khagarijan College, Chotahaibor, Nagaon, Assam, hereinafter referred to as 'DAKC' and Department of Assamese, ADP College, Nagaon, Assam, hereinafter referred to as 'DAADP' hereinafter individually referred to as 'the Party' and jointly referred to as 'the Parties'.

#### Acknowledging that:-

1. KC is a Degree level provincialized higher education institution, having its address as Chotahaibor, Nagaon, Assam, 782003.
2. ADPC is a Degree level provincialized higher education institution, having its address as South Haibargaon, RRB Road, Nagaon, Assam, 782002.

**Desiring to:** Enhance the support the cooperation between the Parties in education and research activities.

**Pursuant to:** the prevailing laws and regulations, policies and procedures applicable in the State of Assam, India has reached the following understanding:

#### Article I

##### Objective of Cooperation

The objective of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to cooperate in educational, research and extension activities in the areas of mutual interest.

#### Article II

##### Scope of Cooperation

The Parties agrees to implement cooperation programmes including but not limited to:

- a. Faculty & Student exchange of the both the Department.
- b. Curriculum development of certificate and Diploma courses.
- c. Cooperation in conducting student's educational field trips.
- d. Undertaking joint research at faculty level.
- e. Cooperation in extension and outreach activities &
- f. Any other areas that mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

#### Article III

##### Location of Activities

- a. The Parties agrees to implement the activities stated in Article II at KC and ADPC.
- b. Any changes to the location of the activities shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.



**Article IV**  
**Executing Agencies**

To implement this MoU:-

- a. **KC** appoints the Coordinator, IQAC, and HoD, Department of Assamese (Hereinafter referred to as KC Rep.)
- b. **ADPC** appoints the Coordinator, IQAC, and HoD, Department of Assamese (Hereinafter referred to as ADPC Rep.)

**Article V**  
**Financial Arrangements**

- a. Any cooperation under this MoU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approved by relevant authorities.
- b. Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and programme specific arrangements.

**Article VI**  
**Intellectual Property Rights**

- a. Each party shall protect, within its capacity and territory, intellectual property rights of the other Party in accordance with the laws regulations in force in the State of Assam and country of India.
- b. In case of specific arrangement, programmes, activities or projects that may result in intellectual property, the Parties shall conclude separate arrangement in accordance with the prevalent laws and regulations in the State of Assam and the country of India.

**Article VII**  
**Confidentiality**

In the event that either Party wish to disclose any data and/or information supplied in or resulted from the implementation of this MoU, the disclosing Party shall have prior written consent of the other Party.

**Article VIII**  
**Limitations of Personal Activities**

The Parties shall ensure that their personnel engaged in the activities under this MoU shall engage only in activities under the framework of this MoU with respect to laws and regulations in the state of Assam and country of India.

**Article IX**  
**Settlement of Duties**

Any dispute concerning the interpretation of this MoU shall be settled amicably through consultations or negotiation between Parties.

**Article X**  
**Amendment**

- a. This MoU may be amended or revised at any point of time by mutual written consent of the Parties, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MoU.
- b. Such amendment or written or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.



**Article XI**

**Entry into Force, Duration and Termination**

- a. This MoU shall come into force from the date of signing i.e., 04/01/2020.
- b. This MoU shall remain in force for a period of **Three Years** and may be extended for another period of **Three Years** by mutual agreement of the Parties.
- c. Either Party may terminate this MoU at any point of time by giving written notification to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MoU, **one** month prior to the termination.
- d. The termination of this MoU shall not affect the completion of any programmes, activities or projects in progress and not completed at the time of termination.

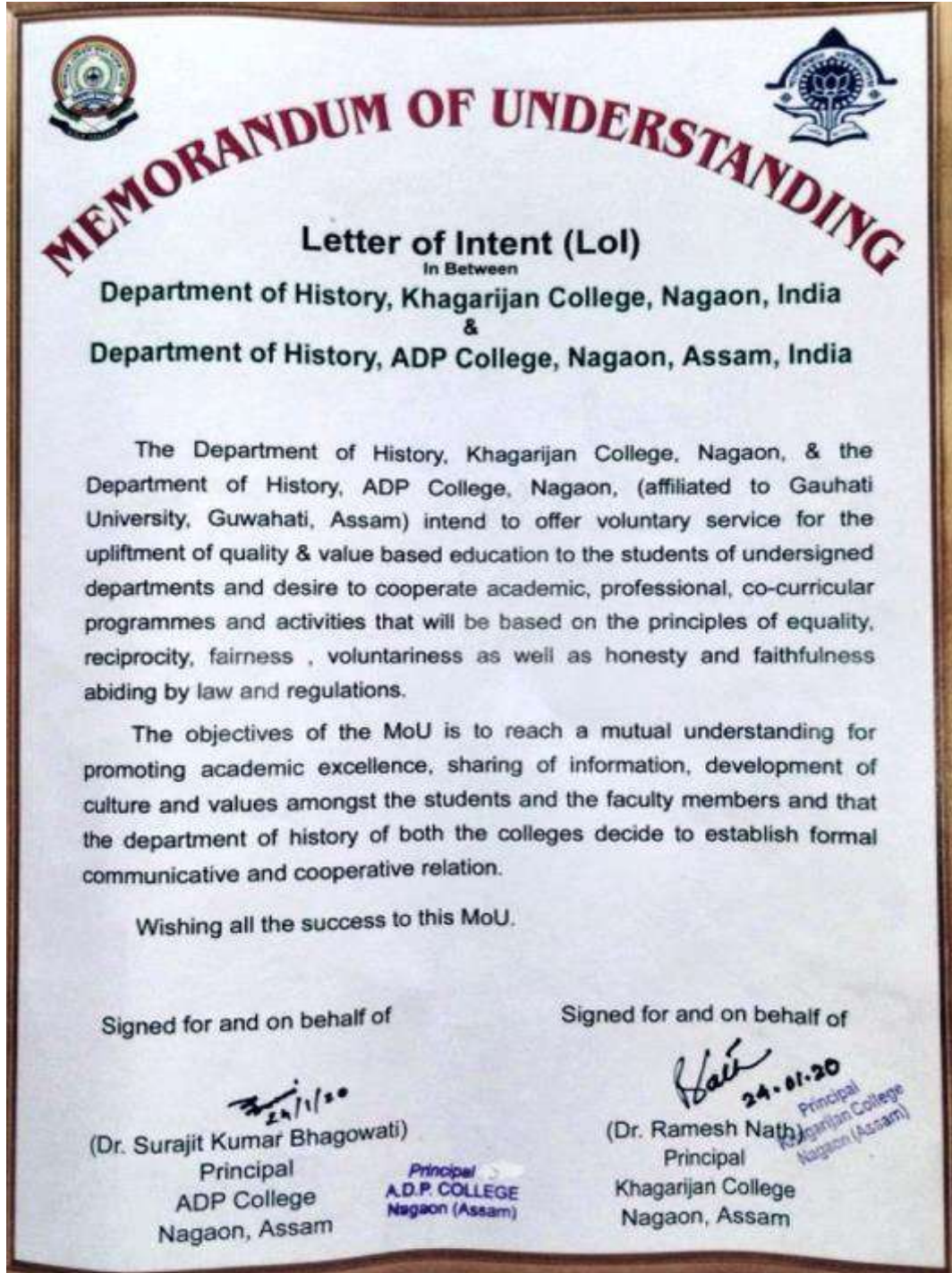



### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of understanding between Khagarijan College ..... (institution) henceforth called the 'host institution' and Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University henceforth called the "University" in respect of organizational responsibilities to act as Study Centre is signed today the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March ..... (month) 2020.

- 1. The host institution shall :**
  - i) admit students (learners) on behalf of the University and receive the admission fee and other fee fixed by the University in the form of bank draft (in case of online admission, it is not required) only for onward transmission to the University and charge no other fee from the learners;
  - ii) provide at least 1 (one) room of about 400 sq. ft. for exclusive use of the Study Centre of KKHSOU;
  - iii) make halls / rooms available to the Study Centre to be used for holding contact classes and examinations, if required.
  - iv) have no right to claim as examination centre.
  - v) hold at least 15 Counselling Sessions on fifteen Sundays for Six Monthly Course and 30 Counselling Sessions on thirty Sundays for One Year Course.
  - vi) extend library facilities to the learners of KKHSOU;
  - vii) provide laboratory and Computer facilities to the learners of KKHSOU for specialized programmes requiring institutional infrastructure facilities on mutually agreed terms;
  - viii) have phone, fax / e-mail facilities;
  - ix) have CC camera in rooms in case the Centre is entrusted with the responsibility of conducting a particular examination of the University
  - x) ensure security of the University properties provided to the Study Centre by the University;
  - xi) not use the equipments and other properties received from the University for any other purpose without written permission from the University;
  - xii) convey to the learners various information and instructions issued by the University from time to time;
  - xiii) display prominently a signboard of KKHSOU Study Centre with the emblem of the University as in reverse page superscribed on it ;
  - xiv) provide space for Notice Board / Wall Magazine for the learners of the Centre
  - xv) allow the authorized officer of the University to inspect the functioning of the Study Centre as and when necessary;
  - xvi) give 6 (six) month's notice to the University in the event of its unilateral decision to discontinue as Study Centre and take full responsibility of the enrolled learner's future on its failure to do so.
  
- 2. The University shall :**
  - i) provide self learning materials (SLM) at the time of admission for distribution among the learners;
  - ii) at the initial stage refund 50 % of the course fee collected from the learners and 20 % of the sale proceeds of application forms and prospectus to the Study Centre for its maintenance including counseling classes;
  - iii) provide one computer with a printer to those Study Centres which enroll more than 150 learners and one TV set with DVD players to those Study Centres enrolling more than 200 learners in order to facilitate its better functioning depending upon the availability of fund, however, the ownership of these equipments will rest with the University
  - iv) defray traveling expenses to the head of the host institution/project coordinator/other faculty members whenever invited/deputed by the University to attend seminar/workshop etc. ;
  - v) give notice to the host institution in case of any unilateral decision to discontinue the study centre on issues of mismanagement & financial irregularities and take full responsibility of the learners of the centre

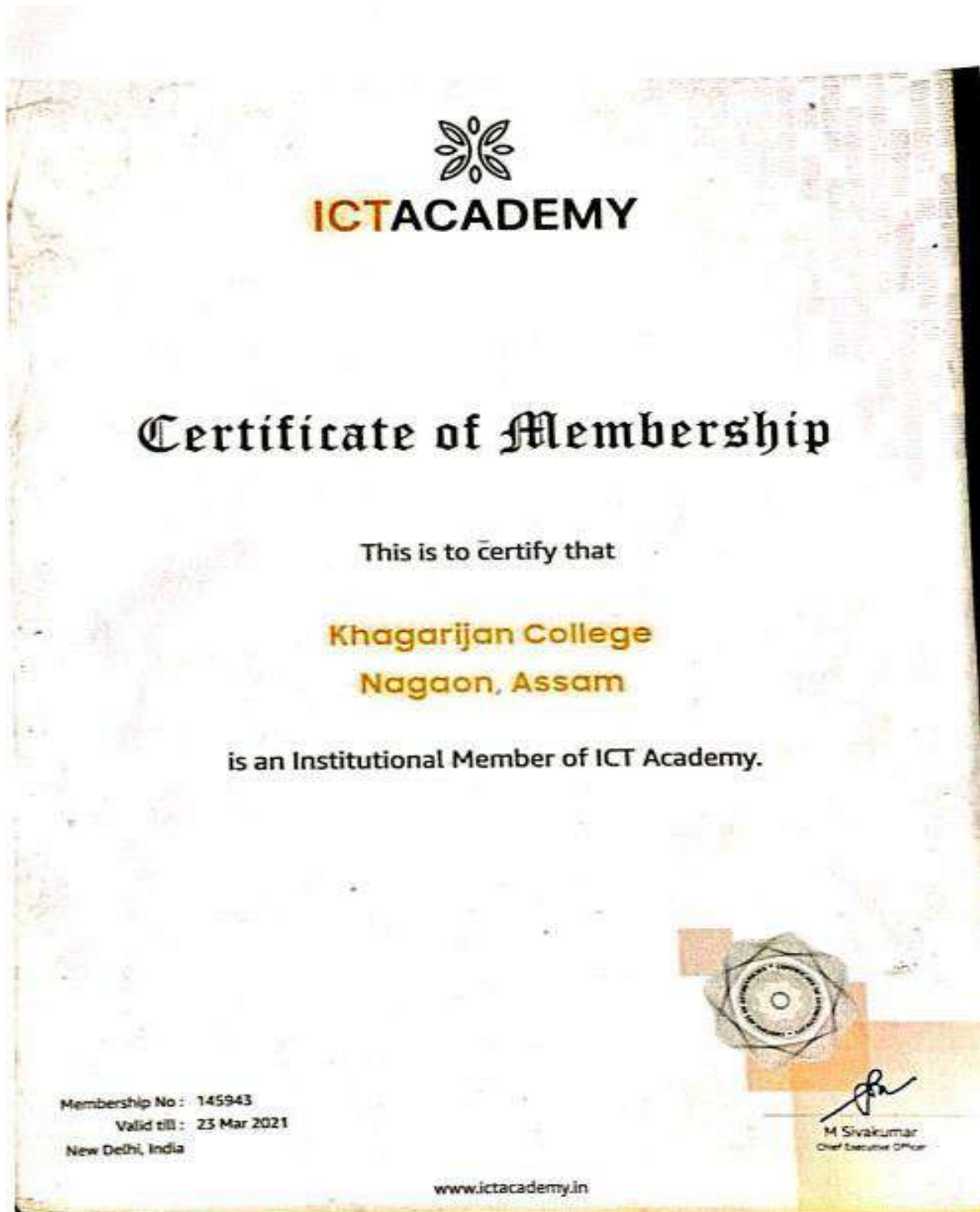

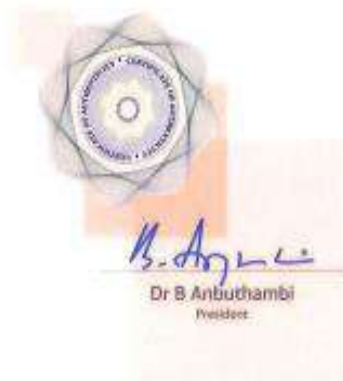

**Responsibilities of the College:**

- (k) To make all reasonable efforts to provide necessary information and technical assistance to the Industry Partner in response to request that fall within the scope of this project, and to share applicable resources that are made available.
- (l) To properly release the payments payable to the Industry Partner against its services as per the scheme guidelines and as agreed mutually.
- (m) To be responsible for the logistics and operational aspects of the training component of the said Schemes.
- (n) To provide timely clarifications regarding Academic Inputs and any other necessary information to the Industry Partner.

2. 4. On approval of the programme by the UGC, Net Skill Foundation, Nagaon will play a proactive role in running the course successfully and efficiently especially in content building, liaisoning on behalf of the College, faculty support, training – faculty & students, On-Job Training and final placement.
5. Both parties, subject to appropriate funding and resource availability, agree to mutually develop skill-based service learning and volunteer opportunities that will expand community organization capacity to meet community needs, and provide necessary services to low-income populations in the college area.
