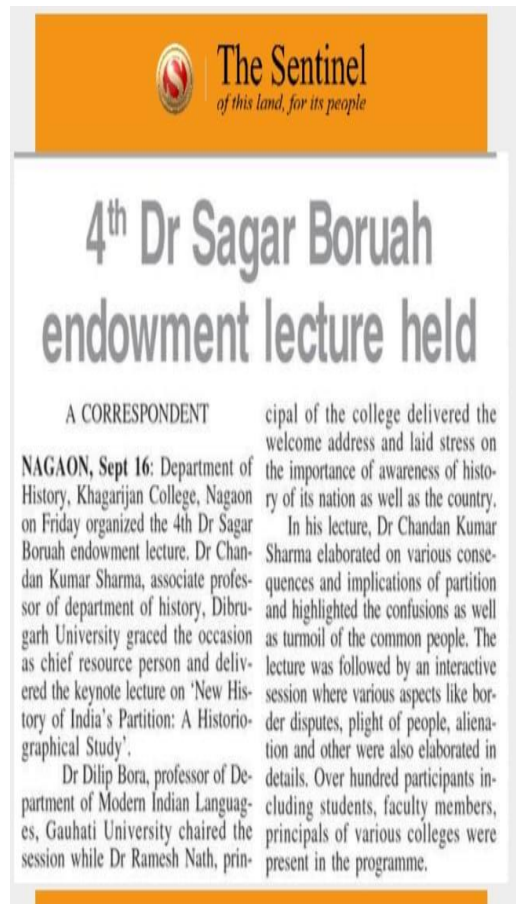


Figure 3: Paper Cutting of The Sentinel

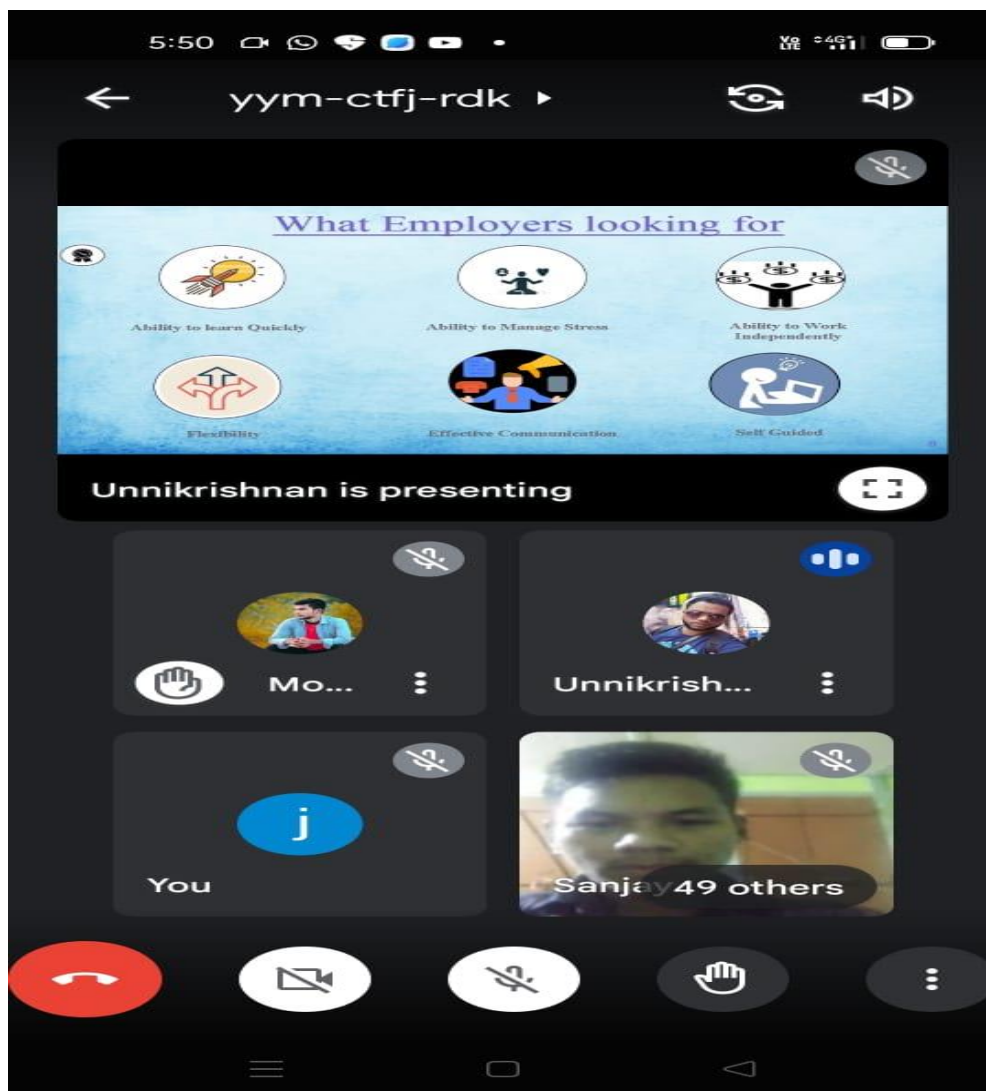


Figure 4: Screenshot of Online Event

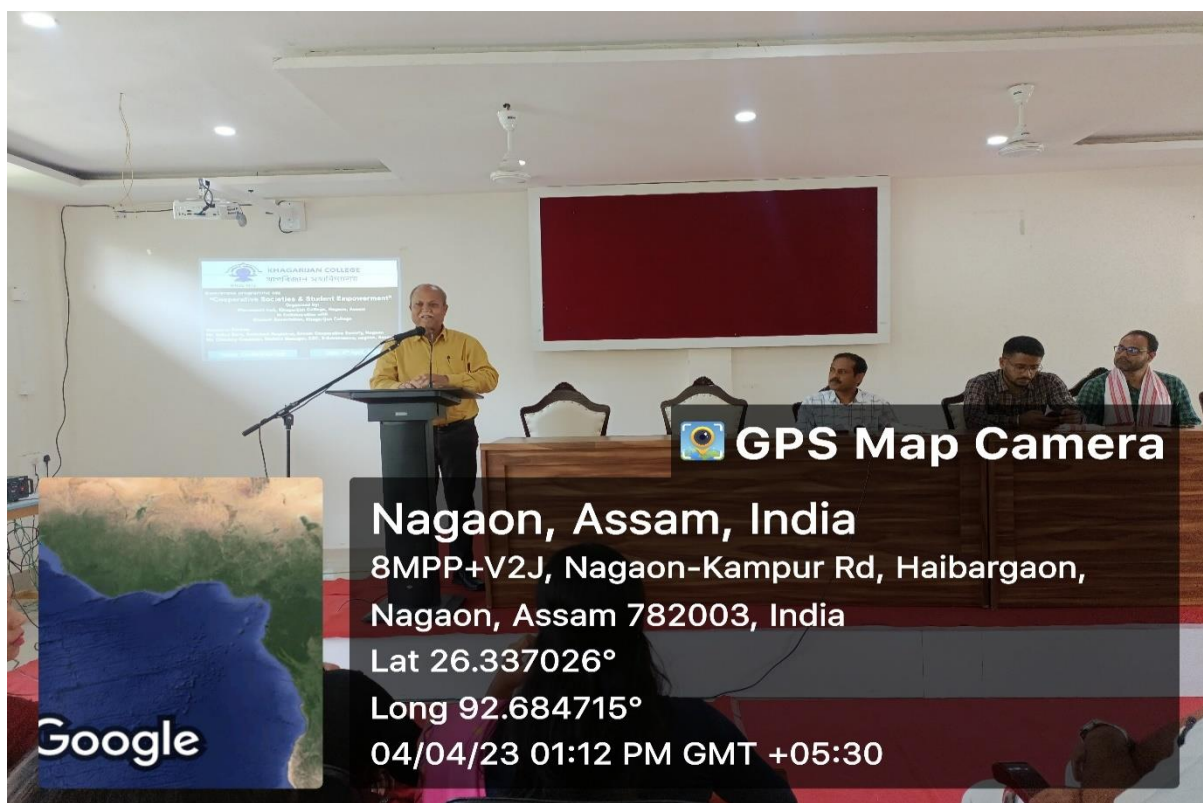


Figure 21: Glimpse of Awareness Programme
